

PARENT INFORMATION – PARTICIPATION RULES

To ensure a safe, pleasant, and creative experience for all children, the following rules apply:

1. Registration & Participation Approval

- Participation is free and requires electronic registration via the official form by the parent/guardian.
- The number of participants is limited a first-come, first-served policy will be followed.

2. Arrival & Departure Times

Activities will take place twice daily in various locations across the island (beaches, squares, school classrooms).

 Morning hours:
 11:00–13:00

 Evening hours:
 19:00–22:00

Children are kindly requested to arrive fifteen (15) minutes early. If activities take place outside the main square, arrival at other locations is the responsibility of the parents.

No child may leave without prior notice to the group leader.

3. Clothing & Personal Items

- Children should wear lightweight, comfortable clothing, athletic shoes or sandals, and a hat.
- They must bring with them:
 - A water bottle
 - o Sunscreen
 - Swimsuit / Beach towel
 - Hand sanitizer / Wet wipes

4. Children's Behavior

Children are expected to:

- Be polite and respectful to all team members and staff.
- Participate in group activities and follow the instructions of supervisors.
- Stay within the Festival premises at all times.
- Respect the space and natural environment.
 Inappropriate or aggressive behavior toward other children or adults will not be tolerated and may result in removal from activities after the parents are informed.

5. Participation in Activities

- All activities are group-based and guided by educators.
- Children are encouraged to express themselves freely, while respecting their peers, staff, and surroundings.

6. Health & Safety Measures

- If a child has a fever or symptoms of illness or gastroenteritis, they should not attend activities.
- Staff members are trained in basic first aid for minor incidents.

7. Photos & Videos

Festival coverage will include photos and videos, always with respect for the children's safety and privacy.
 If you do not wish your child to be photographed, please indicate this in the registration form.

8. Parent Communication

- Each activity will have a designated supervisor responsible for parent communication.
- In case of emergency, parents will be contacted immediately via the phone number provided.
